## SITE SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

Local Law 196 requires increased site safety training by

**December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019**

To address an alarming rise in construction-related injuries and deaths in New York City, the Building Department has issued a new **Site Safety Training (SST)** requirement for workers and supervisors. The first phase of the SST program began in March 2018 and required all workers to complete at least a 10 Hour OSHA course. By the next deadline in December, workers need a total of **30 hours** of safety training to get a "Limited" SST card, while supervisors need **62 hours** of training for the "Supervisor" SST card.

### Who needs Site Safety Training?

Workers and supervisors working on any permit job with a site-safety plan under Local Law 81.

### Who doesn't need Site Safety Training?

Engineers, architects, developers, delivery and security persons, flaggers, special inspectors, and DOB trade licensees such as master plumbers.

### Who is liable for worker training?

Permit-holders must ensure training requirements are met. Violations up to \$5000 will apply to the owner, permit-holder, and employer (if different).

### What do workers need by December 2019?

A 30 Hour OSHA card fulfills the upcoming SST requirement. A total of 40 hours of safety training will be required by September of next year.

### What do Supervisors need by December 2019?

Superintendents, competent persons, and safety personnel need the 30 Hour OSHA along with 32 additional hours of training outlined by the DOB.

### What are the requirements for recordkeeping?

A log of completed training with copies of each worker's training cards will be maintained on-site.

### What topics will Site Safety Training cover?

Heavy focus on fall prevention, plus scaffold use, drug and alcohol awareness, Chapter 33 safety codes, and other topics relevant to each class.

### Will previous training apply towards SST?

Some training topics like supported scaffold work and rigging may count towards SST. We'll track your training and help meet your requirements.
